NAPLAN

Students in Years 3 and 5 will complete the National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) from 13th - 24th May. This year, for the first time, Year 3 and 5 students will complete the NAPLAN assessments online, with the exception of the Year 3 Writing test which will be completed with pencil and paper. Students have practiced using the online testing and this has proved to be engaging and running smoothly. Results from NAPLAN will be issued in September. Please contact your child's class teacher if you have any questions or concerns.

ENROLMENT OPEN FOR 2020

We invite you to make an enrolment application for our Kindergarten and Pre-primary programs in 2020. To be eligible to apply for a Kindergarten place, your child should turn 4 years old by 30 June 2020. Pre-primary enrolments are open to students who will be 5 years old by 30 June 2020. Information packages and application forms can be picked up from the front office. Applications close on Friday 26th July. Each year the school fills to capacity, particularly in Kindergarten, so it is essential that applications for enrolment are received by the cut-off date. Zones of Regulation

Last term many of our staff participated in a workshop on ‘Zones of Regulation’. This is a fantastic resource designed to help students regulate (or control) their emotions. This resource helps teach what the different ‘zones’ are, what the expected behaviours are in each zone and which environments different behaviours are expected in. For example, when a student plays in the playground areas, it is beneficial for he or she to feel more alert and excited and run around; however, more alert and excited and running is not appropriate in the library. It is important to remember there are no ‘bad’ or ‘naughty’ zones and all zones are expected at one time or another.

Blue sad sick tired bored	Green happy calm focused ready to learn	Yellow frustrated worried silly excited	Red mad/angry terrified elated out of control

The ‘Zones’ describe how your brain and body feel:

Blue Zone- The body is moving slowly.

Green Zone- Like a green light: “Good to go!”

Yellow Zone- Proceed with caution and slow down!

Red Zone- extreme emotions! Trouble making good decisions and must stop.

Which zone is best for learning in? The GREEN ZONE!

When students can identify what emotion they are feeling and what zone they are in, they will be empowered to do something differently if they need to get back to the GREEN ZONE.
