installation of the shiny, bright, double-slided playground as selected by the Year 3 and 4 students themselves, along with a special surprise of a bird's nest swing. It has been the hottest property in town this week, and marks the fourth new playground launched in our school in almost as many years. This playground was made possible with funding from the Minister for Education and Department of Education totalling \$25 000 with a further \$13 000 from the school reserve to top up the sandpits, add the bird's nest swing and install a new limestone retaining wall.

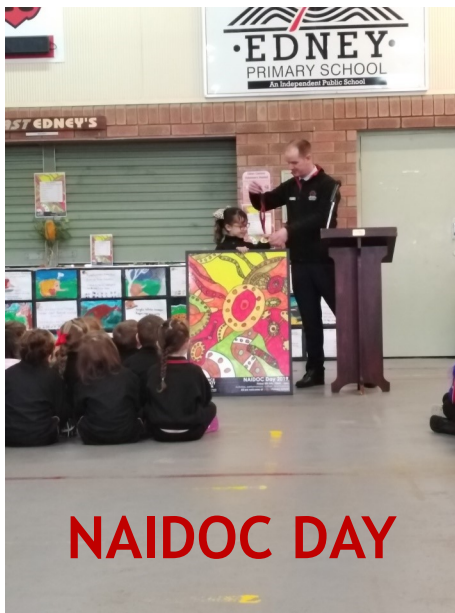
