











ABOUT LISTENING GYLPHS

Glyphs are pictures of facts. Listening glyphs provide young students with a way to express the "facts" about what they hear in a musical selection.

CONTENTS

General Listening Glyph (For any piece of music)
Listening Glyph for Star Wars "Main Title"
Blank Listening Glyph (Greater freedom to assess any piece of music)

INSTRUCTIONS

Discuss the worksheet, and then listen to the recording. Ask students to begin coloring each part of the picture based on what they hear. Play the recording 2 or 3 more times as they color their picture.

EXTENSION

Steady Beat - If students are struggling to hear a steady beat, pass out hand drums and ask them to play a steady beat with the recording.

Trumpet/Percussion - The Star Wars "Main Title" worksheet asks students to identify if a trumpet and percussion instruments are playing. Consider preceding this lesson with brass family and percussion family lessons.
