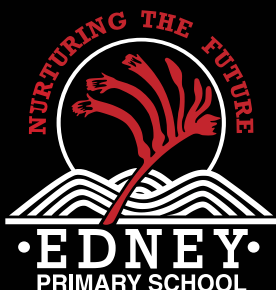

History

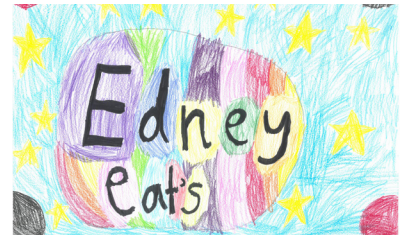
Edney Primary School has had a Canteen service in operation all but 6 months of our 31 year history. Initially operated under the management of the P&C, the Canteen saw its share of ups and downs and challenges, as well as triumphs in building, feeding and supporting our students, school and community. Over the first thirty years, the canteen saw two names, and two amazing managers who worked tirelessly to provide this service to families.

The P&C ceased responsibility for the Canteen at the conclusion of 2019, at which time the school began the search for a business to provide this service on the school site. After a competitive and open tender process, High Wycombe IGA was awarded the contract to provide the canteen service on site at Edney Primary School for an initial term of 5 years.

Edney Eats officially opens for business on the first day of Term Three, Tuesday 21st July 2020.

Name and Logo

A name and design competition was held during Term Two, inviting entries from students, staff and parents for a new name for the Canteen's new era. We will always love and remember Fast Edney's and it has a special place in our school's history and heart. Its legacy will be preserved, and our canteen will have a fresh start.



The name and logo of Edney Eats is the combination of two entries received through our competition. The name comes from Skye Jones in Year 2, while the logo was designed by Lloyd Jones, one of our casual staff members. In bringing together the name and logo design, a graphic designer was engaged who melded the concepts along with Edney Primary School and IGAs corporate colours to come up with a modern and fresh design and identity for Edney Eats.



Operating Model

Edney Eats is a standalone, independent business owned and operated by High Wycombe IGA. It operates on a similar model to the school's agreement with Lowes in providing school uniforms. The key difference is that Edney Eats is located on the school site.



Staff

Edney Eats staff are employees of High Wycombe IGA. Any staff who will be working on site at Edney Eats have undergone the same background checks, clearances and induction as a staff member of the Department of Education would and all hold valid Working with Children Checks and National Criminal History Screening Clearance.

Operation and Information

As a standalone business, the school is not permitted to share any information about your child without your express consent, nor can the school facilitate your purchases, negotiate payment plans or seek to extend credit.

Like a standalone business in the broader community, Edney Eats will not provide free lunch or emergency lunch, allow credit accounts or booking up. It is strictly cash (or EFTPOS) and carry. Please consult with Edney Eats staff should your child have any allergies or specific dietary requirements of which the food service must be aware.

The Menu

Edney Eats will launch with the Winter Menu, which covers Terms 2 and 3. A Summer Menu for Terms 1 and 4 will be prepared and issued prior to the commencement of Term 4. Prices in the Menu are fixed, and will not fluctuate, with the exception of an annual review in tandem with any menu updates.

The Menu is comprised of a vast selection of everyday options, as well as a daily featured selection. In addition, specific recess items, lunch snacks and drinks, and after lunch treats are included on the menu. From time to time, there will be promotional specials, limited time menu options and meal deals to coincide with school events, special days, and just for fun! The most recent menu for Edney Eats is available anytime from the Edney Primary School website, Facebook group or app, as well as through the online ordering platform **QuickCliq**.

The Traffic Light System

Edney Eats, like all school canteens in Western Australia must operate in accordance with the Healthy Food and Drink Policy of the Department of Education, which has been in place since 2007. This policy classifies all foods, drinks and snacks into categories, and colour codes them as follows:

Green: Food and drinks classified **GREEN** in the traffic light system are recommended for everyday consumption. The majority (and absolute minimum 60%) of all items on the menu must be **GREEN** choices. These are the healthiest choices.

Amber: Food and drinks classified **AMBER** in the traffic light system are not recommended as everyday choices and their availability to students should be limited. No more than 40% of foods, drinks and snacks offered can be **AMBER** products.

Red: Food and drinks categorised as **RED** in the traffic light system are not permitted in WA Public School canteens or food services.

The Edney Eats Menu includes traffic light symbols next to all products to indicate the category.

Online Ordering

- Edney Eats online ordering is available for days or weeks in advance.
- You can make a one-off, recurring or custom pattern order.
- Online ordering is available 24 hours per day, but orders for same day fulfilment must be placed no later than 9am.
- Payment must be made at time of ordering online.

Over the Counter Ordering

- Edney Eats opens for orders at 8.20am. Orders need to be written onto order bags, and can include pre-order for recess items, lunch, drinks and snacks and desserts.
- Over the counter ordering closes at 9.00am.
- No late orders can be accepted.
- Payment via cash or EFTPOS.

Order Fulfilment

- Recess Orders will be available for pick-up from a custom line in the undercover area.
- Kindergarten and Pre-primary recess orders will be delivered to a distribution point in the Early Childhood Block by a member of the Edney student leadership team.
- Lunch orders are packed into baskets and are delivered to classrooms via classroom lunch monitors.
- Over the counter sales are available for recess and following dismissal for play at lunch at 1.15pm for ice-cream, dessert and drink sales.
- Edney Eats closes at 1.30pm.

- For parents and staff, enjoy a morning jolt with barista quality Segafredo coffee for just \$2.00, available from 8.20am.

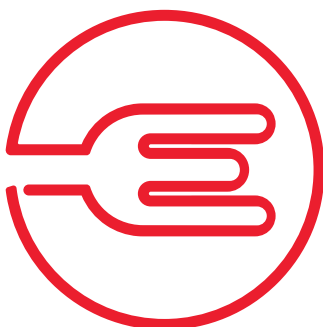
Only the beginning
