NAPLAN

All students in Years 3 and 5 at Edney will complete the National Assessment Program in Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) during May of this year. Edney Primary School delivers these tests online, during school, with students using familiar devices that they have practiced with throughout the year.

For Year 5 students only, the Writing portion of the test is also completed by typing. Year 3 students will continue to complete the writing assessment using pencil and paper.

Comprehensive parent information is being sent directly to Year 3 and 5 families. There is no need for families to complete any preparation, or place any pressure upon the children.

The NAPLAN assessments will simply form part of our regular school programs. Additional information will be coming home today with all students in Year 3 and Year 5.
